The best connection from Würzburg to Schweinfurt is by train, takes 34 min. and costs € 7 - € 11. Alternatively, you can take the bus, which costs € 5 - € 7 and takes 35 min.



With the semester ticket you can use all buses and streetcars at your place of study in Würzburg or in Schweinfurt free of charge.

Museum Georg Schäfer

Schweinfurt presents itself as a city with numerous opportunities for outdoor activities and cultural offerings, such as the Georg Schäfer Museum. Discover German art from the 18th to the 20th century, exhibited in an exciting architecture.



Studentenwerk Würzburg

Student dormitories are maintained at the Würzburg and Schweinfurt campuses by the Studentenwerk Würzburg. They are located only a few minutes' walk from the university and offer fully equipped rooms as single apartments or rooms in shared apartments.



Main (river)




Old Crane

What characterizes studying at FHWS?

FHWS – University of Applied Sciences Würzburg-Schweinfurt

At FHWS, we guarantee an excellent, globally recognized academic education. As a public institution, we offer more than 40 practice- and future-oriented degree programmes at ten different faculties. At our two locations in the heart of Europe, Würzburg and Schweinfurt, there are 9,100 students.

Internationality
Our University cooperates with over 200 partner institutions worldwide. We welcome over 150 exchange students each academic year. As FHWS has introduced English-taught Bachelor's programmes, students from over 90 nations are enrolled at FHWS.

Good professor-student ratio
Studying at FHWS is characterized by small study groups and a very good professor-student ratio. Participating in a high number of seminars teaches you to work independently, and working on projects will enhance your team working skills.

Practical relevance
Approximately 200 professors with profound working experience from industry and business provide an academic education with a particular practical relevance. In more than 90 laboratories, students deepen their theoretical knowledge acquired during lectures.

The German CHE has been ranking FHWS amongst the best universities for years. In 2015, the Bachelor's degree programme Computer Science was ranked the best programme in Germany. In 2016, the Bachelor's degree programme Architecture was ranked 5th, and in 2017, the degree programme Business and Engineering had a leading position in the field of internationality. Each year, FHWS has outstanding valuations in the international U-Multirank.



What makes study life at FHWS special?

Student support
The International Office at FHWS organizes an Orientation Programme for international students twice a year, before the beginning of each semester. During the semester, we offer numerous cultural events.

Orientation Programme
During the Orientation Programme, we support you with administrative formalities, answer questions about your studies, and help you get adjusted to your life in Germany.

During the semester, we organize trips and company visits, but also intercultural workshops to help you get to know Germany, its culture and people better.

Where is FHWS located?

Franconia
Both FHWS locations Würzburg and Schweinfurt are in one of the most beautiful regions in Germany. Located in the northern part of Bavaria, Franconia is one of the sunniest regions in Germany. This benefits especially the viticulture. Their geographic position makes both cities Würzburg and Schweinfurt the perfect starting points to explore Germany and Europe. The international airports in Frankfurt and Munich can be reached easily: It takes approx. 90 minutes to Frankfurt and three hours to Munich.

Würzburg: sports, studies, and leisure
With its approx. 130,000 inhabitants, Würzburg is one of the largest cities in Bavaria. The city is characterized by its high number of students and the mild climate. Enjoy yourself in multiple bars or cafés or with lots of cultural events hosted by theatres or museums. The Würzburg Residence is one of the most important castles in Europe and belongs to the UNESCO world heritage. Another important part of Würzburg is sports. Würzburger Kickers play in the second soccer league, Fuchse Rimpfing show their excellent handball skills

Schweinfurt: combines art and industry
With its approx. 54,000 inhabitants, Schweinfurt belongs to the most growing cities in Germany. It is a particularly important economic hub in the region. Many regionally and internationally operating companies such as Schaeffler, Bosch Rexroth, SKF, and ZF are based there. The city has the highest job density in Germany and provides excellent job prospects for students. Schweinfurt has multiple outdoor activities and cultural offers, including lots of museums with important collections and exhibitions.
